The 13<sup>th</sup> Annual U.S. University Fair organized by the Cyprus Fulbright Commission will take place on Tuesday, October 5<sup>th</sup> from 4:00 to 8:00pm at the J. William Fulbright Center in Nicosia. The fair is administered by the Cyprus Fulbright Commission.

As the official *EducationUSA Advising Center* in Cyprus, the Cyprus Fulbright Commission is authorized by the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs of the U.S. Department of State to actively promote U.S. higher education by offering accurate, unbiased, comprehensive, objective and timely information about educational institutions in the United States.

The fair provides an excellent opportunity to meet with prospective students from some of the best secondary schools throughout Cyprus - both public and private. Last year, our fair attracted 500 students from both the Greek Cypriot and Turkish Cypriot communities as well as many high school counselors from both communities. Sixty-seven percent of the students who attended our 2009 fair were prospective undergraduates and 33% were prospective graduates.

To register, please return the following by Friday, July 16, 2010:

- (1) Completed 2010 College Fair Registration Form
- (2) Registration fee of \$350 (or \$500 for checks postmarked after July 16). Checks should be made payable to the Cyprus Fulbright Commission and should be mailed to Revy Payiata-Chishios, Cyprus Fulbright Commission, PO Box 24051, 1700 Nicosia, Cyprus. Payments can also be made by bank transfer.



Institutions that have awarded a scholarship (covering at least 50% of tuition) to a Cypriot student for the academic year 2010-11 will have their registration fee waived. In order to waive the fee, we must receive an official letter of award before the July 16 registration deadline.

## **LATE REGISTRATION**

Late registration (for payments received after the July 16 deadline) is accepted on a space available basis and will only be accepted with a late registration fee.

## **CANCELLATION POLICY**

- Dated after August 6- no refund.

## **CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION**

- Registration is limited to U.S. regionally accredited institutions.
- Satellite campuses are required to attend under the registration of their main campus.
- Participation is limited to members of the admission/recruitment staff, alumni, professors or current students.
